As a member of the Let's Connect interdisciplinary team, the Child and Youth Worker cooperates with Community Health Centre staff, and various partner agencies to provide opportunities and environments that stimulate healthy development, primarily with families and parents of children 0-12 years of age.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- * Child and Youth Worker Diploma or equivalent education and experience.
- * Membership in the Ontario Association of Child and Youth Workers, an asset.
- * Minimum three to five years community experience with demonstrated skills in working with children 0-12 years old and families.
- * Excellent programming and group facilitation skills.
- * Standard First Aid/CPR Certificate.
- * Experience working in a rural setting a definite asset.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * Work in cooperation to develop, plan, implement and evaluate programs, curricula and maintain environments that foster healthy physical, cognitive, emotional, social, and creative growth and development in children 0-12 years of age and youth.
- * Support children and families at risk with appropriate interventions and positive learning environments.
- * Ensure the safety and promote the health of children individually and as groups.
- * Ensure ongoing partnership with community children's services agencies and partner agencies.
- * Assist ECE in children's programming for 0-6 year olds.
- * Provide behaviour support to clients with extra needs within programming.
- * Role will include leading and/or supporting infant childcare during programs/appointments, cooking programs, children's fitness programming (age range 3 to 9 years), parenting programs, tutoring programs, large events and community committees.
- * Provide proper supervision and guidance for children aged 0-12 years of age.
- * Participate in collection and documentation of outcome and evaluation measures.
- * Strengthen the community in its supports for healthy development of children and their families.
- * Position is Monday to Thursday and includes evening work weekly.
