Walk-in Hours Resume for Specific Populations at Southwestern Public Health COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics

Beginning today, Southwestern Public Health's three COVID-19 vaccination clinics resume walk-in hours to prioritize specific populations, including pregnant women, anyone eligible seeking a first dose, and seniors aged 70 and older seeking a booster. Full details:

- Walk-ins welcomed for these populations between 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. during regular operating hours, including when a clinic is open on a Saturday
- Clinic locations include the St. Thomas Memorial Arena Auditorium, Woodstock Reeves Community
 Complex Goff Hall, and Tillsonburg Community Centre Lions Auditorium (February 2 and March 2)
- Opportunities to expand walk-in hours to additional populations will be evaluated over the coming weeks
