How to Book a COVID-19 Vaccination Appointment

You can book an appointment in St. Thomas, Mount Brydges or London in one of two ways:

Book by phone: 226-289-3560

Book on-line: www.covidvaccinelm.ca

You must have your health card available when you book your appointment
Prior to your appointment you must complete the COVID-19 vaccine consent form
The most current consent form is available on the Southwestern Public Health website
