A Rural Homelessness Systems Navigator (RHSN) provides housing related supports to individuals and families experiencing homelessness or households at imminent risk of losing their housing focusing on clients in Rural West and East Elgin communities.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- The RHSN will assess referrals internally, from external community partners or from self-referrals and provide rapid emergency housing options. This position also serves as a resource for walk-ins to West Elgin Community Health Centre and Family Central Apartments.
- Provide client-centred, trauma informed case management to assist clients with identifying barriers to obtaining or retaining housing, connecting them with income supports, legal consultation, medical resources, financial assistance, employment, available private market options, transportation and information about community resources.
