Prenatal and Infant Programming - Our Registered Nurse offers prenatal classes and telephone assistance on any questions you may have about pregnancy, labour and delivery, breastfeeding and growth and development of your infant. **Breastfeeding Support** - Call our Registered Nurse for breast pump rental, breastfeeding information and home visits.

**Grow with Baby Clinics** - The clinics provide an opportunity to talk to a nurse and a dietitian while weighing and measuring your baby from birth to 18 months.
