Transporting people safely and professionally, the accessible van driver travels to locations such as London, St. Thomas, Chatham, and the surrounding communities in all weather conditions. The driver is also responsible for performing thorough vehicle safety inspections, completing required documentation, and complying with legislation including the Ontario Traffic Safety Act / MTO Regulations.

- \* Experience operating a wheelchair lift and a minimum of three years' driving commercial fleet or buses preferred.
