This crucial support work assists clients with personal daily living activities such as personal care, light housekeeping, laundry services, medication reminders, security checks, and social support.

Qualifications and Experience:

- * Personal Support Worker, Developmental Services Worker certificate or equivalent required. Nursing students are also invited to apply.
- * Current CPR/1st Aid Certificate or willingness to obtain required.
- * Experience providing services to seniors/adults with disabilities in their home and previous support to dementia clients an asset.
