Becoming a Primary Care Client

Call, e-mail or drop by the Centre and request an application form for primary care services.

Your completed application will be reviewed to determine care needs and who is best to meet those needs. It may be an NP or MD. You will be called for an intake appointment. Applications are typically processed in the order received.

At the intake appointment you and the Provider will discuss your care needs, expectations and what we are able to offer. If you both decide that this is the right fit for you, then you will officially become a registered primary client of the Centre.

Primary Care Services

Our team of physicians, nurse practitioners and nurses work within an interdisciplinary team to address your preventative, acute, chronic and palliative health care needs.

In addition, they work with you to address social, economic and environmental challenges that can also affect your health.



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Our Primary Health Care team includes physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, registered practical nurses and medical secretaries

NPs and MDs are often called “providers”. They each have their own roster (panel) of clients. They are responsible for the health care needs of their own clients.

It is ideal for all of your healthcare needs to be met by your own provider as they know you and the plan for your care best. This also promotes continuity of care and helps you to build strong relationships as well.

In the event that your provider is not available and your need is of an urgent nature, you may be offered an appointment with another provider.
