The Registered Practical Nurse works as part of the Centre's First Five Team. Working alongside a Nurse Practitioner, this role provides services on site in West Lorne and St. Thomas as part of a Pediatric Outreach Program supporting the care needs of unattached pediatric clients ages 0-5.

This role includes the screening of unattached infants and children ages for physical, cognitive, language, social, emotional, developmental, nutritional, and behavioural milestones.
